We Listen

Ride On, King Jesus is a historic African-American spiritual. Most of the songs in this genre can be traced to enslaved black peoples living in the southern United States in the century or so prior to the Civil War. Many of these spirituals contained hidden messages about freedom and veiled references to escape, and are thus called Underground Railroad songs. Ride On, King Jesus contains a text whose purpose appears to be a strictly spiritual one - one that acknowledges that those who are enslaved are of equal worth to their owners, for Jesus "died for the rich and he died for the poor." Hallelujah!

We Receive

All congregations in MCC practice an open communion. We believe that communion is a visible sign of Christ's presence and God's grace that each one of us, friend or member, may receive. Simply come forward as the ushers direct.

During Communion, you will be invited to share a moment of invitation to the Presence of God followed by a simple blessing that God's Presence remain with you in your journey.

We use grape juice for the cup. If you desire intercessory prayer, our Fisher's Net Prayer Ministry team is available following both services to pray with you.
