

A LIFE OF ENOUGH:

For Ourselves, For Our Church, For The World

Next week we gather the financial commitments you make to advance God's work through Resurrection MCC. Please pray and prepare to bring your commitment card forward that day. This season we continue to celebrate our summer commitments that already take us 51% of the way to our goal. And we continue to invite everyone to be in the journey of generosity from just starting off to tithing 10% into even greater abundance. Specifically, if we are already have a commitment based on a percentage of our income we are asked to increase that commitment by 1-2% of our gross income. If I currently give 5% that increases my commitment to 6-7% of my income. Some respondents this summer moved from 10% to 12%. And also specifically, if we haven't made a consistent commitment, we are asked to calculate what starting at 5% of our income would be and making a first step to achieve that goal. On the back of our commitment cards, is a helpful graph to see what increments by percentages could mean for you. It is a journey for everyone— one step at a time.

Creating a life of enough encourages us to be clear with our commitments, our values, and to choose to grow that which gives us meaning, thankful for what we have received, trusting God into our future.
