## Sermon Series: Broadway

Love the sinner, hate the sin.

Continued use of these phrases can lead people to avoid complex issues, be hurt, or even draw incorrect conclusions about God that can push people away from faith. By taking a healthy look at these half truths in the scope of biblical context and interpretation, we can each play a role in encouraging the greater truths found in Jesus Christ to be revealed.

### Community


