A central theological question over the years, however, is about the nature of human life - is it altogether sinful in light of the Fall? Maybe it's just another human thing, like eating and sleeping.

If sexual pleasure is such a common-nearly universal-human experience, what makes a difference for people, what makes exploring these early theologians' work important, is how we interpret that pursuit of pleasure. Does it necessarily require turning away from God: does sexual pleasure incite lust or incline us toward sin? Should we interpret that pursuit as sinful and worthy of shame, or as good and natural?

More pressingly, I wonder about the effects of teaching children that something that is natural and commonplace is sinful.






