Resurrection MCC is a Christian church that follows God's call to justice for all people. We build on a rich history of social justice for, and on behalf of, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer people. Since its founding in 1968, Metropolitan Community Churches have been at the vanguard of civil and human rights movements as an international advocate for vulnerable people in places where religious orthodoxy, sexism, transphobia and homophobia can result in violence and death. MCC has been on the forefront in the struggle towards marriage equality in the US and other countries worldwide and continues to be a powerful voice in the LGBTQ equality movement. MCC's ministry reaches over 43,000 members in over 250 churches in 22 countries worldwide.

# Creating a Welcoming Space for Everyone

Resurrection MCC is committed to creating a positive environment for our congregation.

Inclusion and Community are two of the fundamental values of Resurrection MCC. Sexual harassment and other forms of violence strike at the heart of both. Harassment, violence, and bigotry create feelings of fear, uneasiness, humiliation, and discomfort. They are expressions of perceived power and superiority by the harasser over another person. Sometimes, even when our actions are not intentionally hurtful, what we say and do can hurt others or make them feel uncomfortable.

Sexual harassment is a form of sexual violence. Sexual harassment and sexual violence is any unwanted attention of a sexual nature, including:

- Remarks about appearance or personal life
- Unwanted flirtations or advances
- Offensive written or visual depictions like graffiti or degrading pictures
- Touching someone without their permission (groping, grabbing, hugging, petting, biting)
- Unwanted sexual demands, pressure, propositions, or requests for sexual activities
- Graphic comments about an individual's body or dress
- Verbal abuse, including sexual insults and name calling
- Rewards for granting sexual favors or the withholding of rewards for refusing to grant sexual favors
- Sexual assault, rape, and sexual violence

Many Resurrection MCC attendees create and build social and sexual relationships with one another. We want to remind you that if you are considering engaging in sexual relationships, consent is essential. Please be sure that all involved have similar expectations and engage in safe sexual practices. Free HIV & STD testing is provided by Fort Bend County Health Services on the first Sunday of each month from 10 am - 2 pm in the Gathering Place. Female and male condoms are available in our restrooms.

Resurrection MCC is proud to host a beautiful and diverse LGBTQ and allied community where vibrant diversity in sexual orientation, gender identity, and gender expression is welcome. It is all our responsibility to ensure that each member of our LGBTQ and ally family feels welcome and affirmed.

Thank you for your help in ensuring that Resurrection MCC is an environment where all worshippers feel safe, comfortable, and celebrated as members of our extended family. 

A \$1,000 scholarship, A Blanket of Love, is being offered to one Resurrection MCC High School Senior who meets the criteria listed. This scholarship has been generously offered by a Resurrection member to assist in defraying a portion of the cost of attending college.

**CRITERIA:** Must have participated in the Resurrection MCC Children and Youth or Teen Ministry for a year • Must be graduating from High School in May or June of 2019 • Must have been accepted into at least 1 accredited college, university, or vocational school for the 2019 Summer or Fall semester • Must provide a letter of recommendation from either one High School teacher / administrator or one regular attendee of Resurrection MCC • Must have a grade point average of 3.5 overall • Must have 15 or more hours of community service with at least 7 of those completed at Resurrection MCC • Must submit an essay explaining how the scholarship will be used in the student's post-secondary education.

Applicants must submit the documentation to the Coordinator of Children and Youth Ministries on or before April 30, 2019. All documentation should be submitted to [Debbie@ResurrectionMCC.org](mailto:Debbie@ResurrectionMCC.org)

All essays will be reviewed by a three-member team of current or former RMCC Children and Youth ministers who will review the documentation and determine the recipient.



## Nursery

### Care Providers Needed

The responsibility of a Nursery Care Provider is an important one. It is often the first contact new or visiting individuals with children have with someone at our church. Our main objective is to provide a clean, safe, happy, and loving environment for our little ones while they are in our care.

**CHARACTERISTICS:** A willingness and ability to follow the instructions and policy of the church, especially as they are related to this position • A strong commitment to providing regular, dependable, loving, quality childcare • A willingness to complete CPR, AED, and First Aid certification class (provided by the church)

**GUIDELINES:** Arrive 30 minutes before any scheduled event to ready the Nursery and to receive the children as they are dropped off • Follow the prescribed check-in/check-out procedures • Clean and straighten the room after all children are gone, following the procedures • Make the Coordinator aware as soon as possible if unable to fulfill a responsibility, so they can arrange for another provider in a timely fashion.
