Choosing Jesus

Many distractions can keep us from choosing Jesus—work, family, possessions, fear, anxiety, greed, scarcity, competition, busyness. It is an intentional choice to keep our faith prioritized for our spiritual health. With these reading from the Gospel of Luke, we will explore Presence, Prayer, Prosperity and Pathway. Our choices can lead us into greater intimacy with God if we only choose wisely which doors to open and which doors to close. It is really our choice.

Two years ago, we celebrated 45 years of Love in Action by launching a campaign with a goal of \$75,000--and thanks to your incredible generosity, we raised just over \$100,000 to love our home, love our neighbor, and love our world!

Your Board of Directors subsequently empowered the use of 25% of these funds for our world to support the denominational efforts through:

- Global Justice Institute
- Our local mission trip to Cuba

- Worship-arts mission to our global MCC General Conference in Orlando


Your board also empowered 75% of these Love in Action funds to love our home. Your generosity made a huge impact:

- Transforming a patched-plywood, broken-glass wall into a stained-glass cross that lights the night (14%); and tending to immediate repairs, replacing parking lights, exterior doors, chiller compressor and chiller electronics board for the Activities Building (18%).
- Long-anticipated repairs to many, many feet of our gutters (12%), and bringing our technology into this decade with computers, scanners, and sound boards (7%).
- Enhanced our worship experience with three new projectors and multicolored light arrays to create amazing effects (18%).
- Along the way, we took the needed breath to look to our future; we refreshed our strategic plan and contracted an engineer to analyze the needs of our Activities Building (6%).





Creating a Welcoming Space for Everyone

Resurrection MCC is committed to creating a positive environment for our congregation.

Inclusion and Community are two of the fundamental values of Resurrection MCC. Sexual harassment and other forms of violence strike at the heart of both. Harassment, violence, and bigotry create feelings of fear, uneasiness, humiliation, and discomfort. They are expressions of perceived power and superiority by the harasser over another person. Sometimes, even when our actions are not intentionally hurtful, what we say and do can hurt others or make them feel uncomfortable.

Sexual harassment is a form of sexual violence. Sexual harassment and sexual violence is any unwanted attention of a sexual nature, including:

- Remarks about appearance or personal life
- Unwanted flirtations or advances
- Offensive written or visual depictions like graffiti or degrading pictures
- Touching someone without their permission (groping, grabbing, hugging, petting, biting)
- Unwanted sexual demands, pressure, propositions, or requests for sexual activities
- Graphic comments about an individual's body or dress
- Verbal abuse, including sexual insults and name calling
- Rewards for granting sexual favors or the withholding of rewards for refusing to grant sexual favors
- Sexual assault, rape, and sexual violence

Many Resurrection MCC attendees create and build social and sexual relationships with one another. We want to remind you that if you are considering engaging in sexual relationships, consent is essential. Please be sure that all involved have similar expectations and engage in safe sexual practices. Free HIV & STD testing is provided by Fort Bend County Health Services on the first Sunday of each month from 10 am - 2 pm in the Gathering Place. Female and male condoms are available in our restrooms.

Resurrection MCC is proud to host a beautiful and diverse LGBTQ and allied community where vibrant diversity in sexual orientation, gender identity, and gender expression is welcome. It is all our responsibility to ensure that each member of our LGBTQ and ally family feels welcome and affirmed.

Thank you for your help in ensuring that Resurrection MCC is an environment where all worshippers feel safe, comfortable, and celebrated as members of our extended family.
