Dear Friend,

“I will make room for you” is the promise we make to God. *Make Room* by Jonathan McReynolds was beautifully sung the first Sunday of October by Cassandra White. The song ends with, “So I will trust the lover, lover of my soul.” During this season of generosity, we have been counting on God’s love — making room and trusting.

We celebrate the many ways people are giving of their time, talent, and treasure. This month alone, we commissioned seven new pastoral care ministers to join the current team of 21 for prayers and presence at home and during stays in the hospital. We celebrated the 22 children participating in Children’s Christian Education each Sunday along with their God liaisons. We celebrated the cast and crew of *Ruthless! The Musical*. We celebrate the start of two new couples’ communities. It is your gifts of time, talent, and treasure that makes all this possible. You consistently and lovingly share many hours of passion; we count on it.

We celebrated a charter member who was the first female and whose son became the first child of our congregation. 
## YOUNG ADULT GLAMPING WEEKEND


## Annual Congregational Meeting

# Creating a Welcoming Space for Everyone

Resurrection MCC is committed to creating a positive environment for our congregation.

Inclusion and Community are two of the fundamental values of Resurrection MCC. Sexual harassment and other forms of violence strike at the heart of both. Harassment, violence, and bigotry create feelings of fear, uneasiness, humiliation, and discomfort. They are expressions of perceived power and superiority by the harasser over another person. Sometimes, even when our actions are not intentionally hurtful, what we say and do can hurt others or make them feel uncomfortable.

Sexual harassment is a form of sexual violence. Sexual harassment and sexual violence is any unwanted attention of a sexual nature, including:

- Remarks about appearance or personal life
- Unwanted flirtations or advances
- Offensive written or visual depictions like graffiti or degrading pictures
- Touching someone without their permission (groping, grabbing, hugging, petting, biting)
- Unwanted sexual demands, pressure, propositions, or requests for sexual activities
- Graphic comments about an individual's body or dress
- Verbal abuse, including sexual insults and name calling
- Rewards for granting sexual favors or the withholding of rewards for refusing to grant sexual favors
- Sexual assault, rape, and sexual violence


